

Lab: Coins

Ask your customer how much money they have (as a decimal without a \$ sign)

Then figure out the least amount of coins needed.



Hints:

- multiply by 100 to get the amount of pennies (don't forget to cast the result as an int)
- divide by 25 to get the number of quarters
- mod by 25 to get the pennies left over so you can keep going
- it would be appropriate to use constants for the coins
