

hello part 2

Make a copy of your hello.c program within your chapter1 folder and call it hello_2.c

Your program will:

1. Ask the user for a name
2. Print a message saying hello to that name
3. Always include at least one comment - even if it is just at the top describing what the program does
4. For programs like this you will run a style50 check, but you don't need (and won't be able) to run a check50

We will be changing to code so that we first ask the user a question, store their input, and print out the message. Enter the code from below, compile, and run your program.

#include <cs50.h>
#include <stdio.h>

// this program will ask the user for a name
// and then print out the answer in a greeting

int main(void)
{
    printf("Enter a name please: \n");
    string name = GetString();
    printf("Greetings, %s \n", name);
}
```
