

Travel Project - Web Design- Fall 2021

Overview: Choose a place that you would like to travel to - this can be a city, country, a particular event, or a more specific location.

** links within your own site only need to reference the page name
- you do not need the entire URL for these to work*

- 1. Include a link that goes back to your portfolio page**
- this will simply be: index.html
- 2. On your portfolio page include a link that will take us to your travel page**
- again this will only need to be the name of the page itself
for example: travel.html

Travel Project Specifications:

Technical Details:

- A seamless tile image for the page background
- A title up in the browser tab
- Sets up 3 divisions: container, logo, content
- A logo of your own design in the header
- this can be from pixabay or your own photo but there should be some editing by adding text, using filters, etc
- Images - includes at least 3 in addition to your logo
- these can be placed on the page content area
- At least one list (*either ordered or unordered*)
- At least one use of an imported Google Font
- At least one use of a table
- images could be inside of a table (optional)
- HTML/CSS code should be neatly arranged and easy to read
- Comments should be included to help make the code easier to understand

Design Consideration:

- Use coordinating colors to present a theme that ties the look of the page together
- Use fonts that go well together and work for their purpose
(example: heading are good for italics, paragraphs of text are better in an easier to read font)
- Creativity - use the tools you have learned to make an attractive, easy to read webpage
- sizes of text, use of padding to create white space
- Information & Visual Impact
*- Would the visitor to your page be inspired to attend this event or travel to this place?
- Is the information easy to quickly read, helpful and informative?*
